LARCC General Rules and Hours of Operation

Hours and days of operation:

Gliders and Electrics may fly 7 days a week, any time of day. Powered aircraft may fly from 8:00 AM to 8:30 PM, 7 days a week.

General Rules:

- 1. A frequency pin is required to turn on your R.C. radio transmitter.
- 2. All flying members must comply with the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) rules at all times.
- 3. No running of engines without restraints at all times in the pits.
- 4. No flying over the pits or the spectators.
- 5. No taxiing in or out of the pits if any pilot station is occupied.
- 6. No flying behind the flight line on our field.
- 7. The maximum sound level is 96db at 9 feet for all engines.
- 8. Long engine runs are to be done in the designated area only. (Helo pit area)
- 9. Utmost care must be taken in preventing engine fuels from contaminating the modeling grounds.
- 10. Absolutely no alcohol consumption at the field.
- 11. Please no litter on the field.
- 12. No unescorted visitors on the flight line.
- 13. Parents are responsible for their children.
- 14. It shall always be the full intention of all LARCC members to at all times respect our neighbors and other members.
