Scott Benson asked if the buckets for lipo batteries has made it to the field or if they are needed yet. Wayne Riemer has the buckets at home still. It was decided to wait until closer to flying season to bring them out.

New Business

President Klade would like to have an update of the field rules. He asked the membership to approve a committee of the Safety Officer, President and Secretary to review and revise the field rules. Shawn Pendleton motioned to allow the creation of said committee, Scott Benson second the motion. Motion passed. The committee would work to get the updates done as soon as possible.

Mark Johnson inquired about reviewing and updating the club by-laws. It was noted that the by-laws were reviewed and updated last year. However, if anyone has any proposed changes or additions that may be needed they can be brought up at any of the club meetings.

Kevin Kopp said that he would like to do an update/redesign on the club website. It has been about 5 years since last done. Kevin would be willing to do the update. The only downside would be that the current site would be taken down while the new site was being built. The game plan would be to take the site to a maintenance mode, create the new front page and maybe a couple other pages and bring the new site back online and then finish adding content over a couple weeks or so. Kenton Tomlinson asked if there would be anyway to add a web cam at the field so people could look and see if someone was flying. It was determined that with the poor cell coverage at the field now it would be difficult. This would be something that could be looked at if the data coverage improved in the future.

Mark Johnson suggested reviving the club calendar on Yahoo that would let people know if someone was planning on coming out. Kevin said that he could look into doing a forum where people could enter that they were planning on going to the field right on the web site. Kenton Tomlinson motioned to have the website updated. Mark Johnson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

President Klade said that this year he would like to establish an events committee. The committee would be responsible for organizing the 3 events the club has planned for this year. The committee would report to the membership during monthly club meetings. The idea is to do some of the organizing in the background and help keep club meetings moving. If you would like to be on the committee please let Tim know. Also, you may be asked to help out on the committees from time to time. Tim established the core of the events committee as himself, Brian Roberts and Kevin Kopp. Again if you are interested please let one of these members know. Shawn Pendleton motioned to accept the events committee as presented. Kevin Kopp seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The final committee that President Klade proposed is a grounds committee. Tim said that he would be doing the mowing of the field this year. It's a big job so he may ask for some help from time to time. Tim asked that if you would like to help with the mowing this year, that you coordinate with him to see what might need to get done. Kevin Kopp motioned to create the grounds committee, Wayne Riemer second the motion. Motion passed.

Scott Benson asked if the club would be interested in having the locus trees ripped out this spring if he could get the right equipment. The club would be appreciative of the effort. More on this closer to spring.

As the club gets new members this year, President Klade wants to have the new members have a face-to-face meeting with one of the board members to go over the field rules, no fly zones, where things are located around the grounds and just an overview of the club. New members would not be allowed to fly until this has been completed. Once done the membership card could be given out. It was also mentioned that it would be a good idea to watch new members fly just to gauge their skill level to see if they might need a little help or not. This is not a formal training program but more to help new members succeed if they are coming in with little or no experience.

With the city using the quarry more this last year, the gate was often left open by them. This allowed access to the field to anyone. Members were reminded that if you see someone you don't recognize flying, it is ok to ask to see an AMA Card or a club membership card.

Kevin Kopp said that the flyer for the swap meet is up on the web site. James Koeppel said he still has post cards from last year and will print up a bunch and bring to the February meeting.

Kevin Kopp volunteered to make up new signs this spring for around the field. Signs identified would be new field rules, spectator signs on the fence, direction signs and at some point a new sign at the gate. Kevin would donate vinyl material but may ask the club for some of the cost of the substrate for the signs. Look for more on that in the future.

Tim Klade said that for the winter meetings he would like to see short demonstrations at club meetings. It doesn't have to be anything fancy, just something to help/teach other club members. Mark Johnson said he would do the February demo.


