Because of the size this year we may want to think about making it a sanctioned event for next year. Tim also thanked Kevin for donating the meat for the event. It looks like after the bills, we should make around \$400.

President Klade made a plea to the membership for more help at these events. If there is not enough interest in helping out with our fund raisers, we can always raise dues and not have events.

James Koeppel said that we need a crew to help re-roof the shelter this coming weekend (May 21-2) starting at 7:30AM. The plan is to concentrate on one side of the roof and see if we will need more shingles. James said he can pick up something to finish off the peak of the roof. Kevin Kopp said the trailer will be there on Friday night. Thank you to James for donating the shingles.

New Business

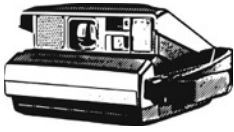

Motion passed.
