Secretary's Report By Kevin Kopp

October 19, 2016

The October meeting was called to order at 7:14 PM by President Koeppel.

There were 10 members present.

Wayne Riemer motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report as read. Ryan XXXX seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Kenton Tomlinson motioned to approve the Secretary's Report as read. Wayne Riemer seconded the motion. Motion Passed

Old Business

The older John Deere is still not up and running James Koeppel motioned to spend up to \$400 for repairs. No second to the motion. Brian Roberts and Kevin Kopp will work on getting the mower running.

President Koeppel asked the membership if anyone had any new ideas for a new dues structure. Ideas that came out a discussion were:

- Some form of an incentive
- Most said that dues should be raised to at least a minimum of what other clubs in the area are
- \$100 for the first year and then lower the following years. If bringing in a new member both people could have \$20 discount on the \$100 in the first year.

Kevin Kopp motioned to change the club's by-laws to remove the associate membership from the club's dues structure. Larry Barnes seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Randy Brue motioned to add to the club's by-laws a 3 time total guest policy. Guests would be able to fly for 3 days total at no charge, after that they would be asked to join the club. Larry Barnes seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Kenton Tomlinson motioned to change the club's by-laws to include a \$100 initiation/ dues for all members starting in 2017. The board of directors would then determine what the dues are for each year going forward starting in 2018, but any new members would be required to pay the one time \$100 initiation fee. Also, if a new member brings in another new member at the same time each would receive a \$20 discount off the \$100 initiation fee. Don Kunath seconded the motion. Motion passed on a 7-2 vote.

President Koeppel also asked if the club was willing to continue doing events.

- The club members would like to continue doing the Dekorra Fireworks as long as they continue to want us. This event is good public relations with very little work for the club to do.
- The several members would like to continue to do an event in September, however scaling back the size.
 Suggestions were to have only a 50/50 Raffle and to have a local community group come in and take care of the food if this event is going to continue.
- Most members would like to continue the May swap meet / fun-fly. The only thing that may change would be not having food at the event.

New Business

Field Winterizing

- Batteries on the mowers will need to be stored or put on chargers
- Mowers need to be cleaned
- Refrigerators cleaned and unplugged
- Rain Barrel drained

The roller has already been drained.


James Koeppel asked if a work day would be needed. It was determined that most of the items can be done fairly quickly and a work day is not needed.


